As part of our science learning we are going to be thinking about electricity and how it is produced and used. As part of this learning we are visiting Fiddlers Ferry Power Station. We are very lucky to have this opportunity and the children will take part in science based activities as well as a trip around the actual power station to see the coal, trains and all of the workings!

Here are the details;

- **WHEN;** Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> January 2017
- **TIME;** this will be all day and will be during school hours. We will be leaving at approx. 9.15am. So being in school for earlier than 5 to 9 that day will be really beneficial.
- **CLOTHES;** Children will need to wear school uniform, and will definitely need a coat.
- **FOOD;** as the children are all entitled to school dinners, our cook, Mrs Whike will prepare a nutritious packed lunch for each child. Mrs Whike is extremely helpful and allows the children pre order their lunch, to ensure that no one goes hungry!
- **COST;** the cost of the trip is £14.50 per child.

During the day the children will;

- ✓ Find out how electricity is produced on a massive scale.
- ✓ Learn about the dangers of electricity.
- ✓ Go around the power station
