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### Safer Internet Day 2023

This week we took part in Safer Internet Day 2023, a national, annual initiative which supports children and young people to develop the skills they need to allow them to use technology and the internet safely and effectively.

This year's theme was 'Want to talk about it? Making space for conversations about life online.' It's important that we help children develop enthusiasm towards the opportunities that are presented by going online. Helping our children to learn to navigate the potential pressures and challenges presented is equally significant.

We launched Safer Internet Day 2023 in school with separate KS1 and KS2 assemblies, so that pupils could learn about issues of particular relevance to their age range. Pupils in Class 1 then learnt about who we can talk to if we see things online that make us feel uncomfortable. In Class 2, the focus was how information spreads online and whether we can believe what we read on the internet. Class 3 learnt about who you can talk to if you feel unsafe online and how you can overcome this feeling.

We recognise the importance of parents' role in equipping children with the skills they need, so I want to signpost you towards some helpful resources and guidance:

Safer Internet Day - advice for parents

Child Exploitation and Online Protection (CEOP)

Together we can work in partnership to equip our children and young people to use the internet effectively and safely.



In RE we made our own PowerPoints about a person who inspired us.


In maths we are learning decimals points. In English we are retelling a story of the Selfish Giant.
