Date: Friday 9th June 2017 (the first Friday back at school after summer half-term).

Times: The coach will leave St Gregory's at 9am prompt and return by 7pm. Please note, due to traffic, the exact return time may vary, however, we will keep you updated on the coach's expected time of arrival to save you any unnecessary waiting.

Clothing: Normal school uniform must be worn, and a **waterproof** coat.

Lunch: Bring a named packed lunch in a **disposable bag** (no lunchboxes please). If you require a school packed lunch please indicate on the slip below. We would suggest extra snacks are packed as it will be a long day for the children.
