The children will walk to Bollington Leisure Centre to keep travel costs down and will be accompanied by Miss Crowther and Mrs Wakeling. Any parents who have a DBS check and are available to help on a rota basis to assist the children in their walk up to the Leisure Centre, please contact school.

## Parents are asked to collect their child from Bollington Leisure Centre at 3.30pm.

We include the following advice for all children

- 1. all jewellery to be removed (as in all P. E. lessons)
- 2. sensible swimming costume/trunks (no long shorts),
- 3. a towel and flannel contained in a waterproof bag.

If your child has any specific medical needs/ conditions (Asthma, sight, hearing needs etc) could you please ensure this information is available in writing to the leisure centre.

Parents should be aware of the risk of damage to eyesight which can be caused by the accidental breakage of goggles whilst swimming. If you wish your child to wear goggles, permission must be given (in writing to the swimming instructor please) and suitable goggles provided.

We value the provision of swimming greatly at St Gregory's as one of the most important life-skills the children will learn.
