Modern Foreign Languages	As linguists we will listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding. We will engage in conversations; ask and answer questions; express opinions and respond to those of others. Speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures. We will present ideas and information orally. We will read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing. We will appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in the language. We will broaden our vocabulary and use a dictionary. We will write phrases from memory and adapt these to create new sentences. We will describe people, places, things and actions orally, and in writing. We will understand basic grammar.
