To link in with our history learning, Class Three have a trip to Quarry Bank Mill planned for Wednesday 30th January 2019. The theme of this term is the history of British clothing, which involves life within the industrial revolution.

Whilst visiting the mill, we will visit the apprentice house, where the children will dress up and be taught as though they were back in time! We will also have the chance to consider what life was like within the mill, which fits with the book we are currently reading as a class- 'Mill Girl'. We will be given an insight into the types of jobs the children were required to do, alongside the payslip they would've received. As well as this, we will be given the chance to see how the machinery was used and dangers that came with it.
