**SWIMMING – SUMMER TERM 2019**

As part of Class 3's PE curriculum, summer swimming lessons will commence on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> May 2019 at Bollington Leisure Centre. The cost of each swimming lesson is £1.40 per lesson or £9.80 for 7 lessons. **The Leisure Centre is now charging 50p per borrowed swimming kit. This will be chargeable to parents at the end of the term. Please ensure your child has their swimming kit on Tuesdays to avoid this.**

The children will walk to Bollington Leisure Centre to keep travel costs down and will be accompanied by Miss Crowther and Mrs Bishop. Any parents who have a DBS check and are available to help on a rota basis to assist the children in their walk up to the Leisure Centre, please contact school.

**The children will be walked back to school by staff members after the lesson. Collection of your child from school as normal.**

We include the following advice for all children

1. all jewellery to be removed ( as in all P. E. lessons)
2. sensible swimming costume/trunks (no long shorts),
3. a towel and flannel contained in a waterproof bag.

If your child has any specific medical needs/ conditions (Asthma, sight, hearing needs etc) could you please ensure this information is available in writing to the leisure centre.

Parents should be aware of the risk of damage to eyesight which can be caused by the accidental breakage of goggles whilst swimming. If you wish your child to wear goggles, permission must be given (in writing to the swimming instructor please) and suitable goggles provided. We value the provision of swimming greatly at St Gregory's as one of the most important life-skills the children will learn.
