- Provide a range of after-school extra-curricular activities designed to enrich your child's experience.
- Ensure that all home learning tasks are given regularly, with an appropriate timescale, and reflect your child's learning needs, (details are given in the Homework Policy).
- Actively welcome parents/carers into the life of the school and ensure that teaching staff are always available, by mutual arrangement, to discuss any concerns you might have about your child's progress or general welfare.
- Keep you informed about the school's activities, policies and guidelines, other general school
 matters and about your child's progress in particular.
- Regularly review the way in which the school communicates with parents and make improvements as required.
- Ensure that all teaching staff are up to date on important educational developments and initiatives which might affect your child and inform you of these where appropriate.
