Happy Friday everyone!

It has been another busy week at Saint Gregory's and we thank all of you for your continued support in so many ways.

As we continue on our journey out of special measures, we will be looking at various aspects of our school day that we can further improve upon.

This week we have started on the pathway of a 'register inspection'. As part of this process, we are asked to look carefully at our attendance figures, 'late marks' and absence percentages etc.

On the whole, we are really proud that we have relatively good attendance at our school and there are only a few areas where we feel we can tighten up on our expectations.

Therefore, as per our attendance policy, please can we remind everyone that our school gates open at 8.45am which is when registration starts. Registration closes at 9.00am. If you arrive at school between 9.00am and 9.15am, a late mark will need to be registered for your child. After 9.15am, the register will be closed and an unauthorised absence will be recorded. This is in line with local authority guidance.

On a positive note, as you will see on page 2 of this newsletter, good attendance and punctuality is always celebrated at Saint Gregory's and you will see 'The Super-Dupers' identified each week.

We do understand that some absences are necessary and these will always be authorised. Furthermore, we <u>really</u> understand how busy the mornings can be in a family home but if you can all try to follow the policy as outlined above, we would really appreciate it!

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
