Reading

Please continue to ensure that regular reading happens at home, as this is essential for pupils to continue to make good progress with their learning and will help them to develop knowledge and skills for their future.

I was asked this week for guidance on how much parents should write in reading records, so I wanted to share some advice. Writing in reading records lets us know that reading has taken place, which allows us to swap children's books when they've completed the required number of reads (3 for Read Write Inc books). As a minimum, therefore, please record the date and a brief comment each time reading takes place. You are welcome to add more detail about how your child read, if this helps you or if it supports your child, though this is not necessary if it makes it harder to fit in reading into your busy lives.
